- The average financial aid package offered to Barton students for 12-13 was \$5,991, which was a combination of federal, state, institutional and other aid.
- \cdot The largest financial aid award paid to a Barton student in 12-13 was \$19,379.
- \cdot 100% of Barton county 2012 high school graduates received some type of financial aid in 2012-13.
- \cdot 77% of the Federal Aid applicants (FAFSA) processed for 12-13 were eligible for a Federal Pell Grant. 68% of the applicants were eligible for the maximum Pell of \$5,550.
- · 31% of students taking at least one BartOnline class received financial aid, VA or Tuition Assistance (or a combination).


