 $\cdot$  100% of Barton county 2016 high school graduates received some type of financial aid in 2016-17.

 $\cdot$  71% of the Federal Aid applicants (FAFSA) processed for 16-17 were eligible for a Federal Pell Grant. 39% of the applicants were eligible for the maximum Pell of \$5,815.


· 21% of students taking at least one BartOnline class received financial aid, VA or Tuition Assistance (or a combination).
