To receive federal financial aid, a student must have a high school diploma or GED. Even though you may have provided a copy of your transcript or diploma to some area on campus at a previous date, Barton's Enrollment Services does not have an official high school or GED transcript on file for you.

Please be advised that we must have an official copy of either your high school or GED transcript on file in Enrollment Services before your federal financial aid will be disbursed.
