
Eligibility for Federal Student Aid

- Have a high school diploma or equivalent
- Be enrolled as a regular student in an eligible degree or certificate program at an eligible institution
- Be registered with Selective Service (if male and between the ages of 18-25)
- Have a valid Social Security number
- Must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress
- Be a U.S Citizen or U.S. National or Eligible Non-Citizen
- Have not borrowed in excess of annual or aggregate loan limits
- Have not received the lifetime limit of Federal Pell grant
- Not have federal benefits suspended or terminated as the result of a drug conviction
- Sign certifying statements on the Free Application for Federal Aid (FAFSA)
 - ✓ Not in default on a federal student loan
 - ✓ Do not owe a refund on a federal Pell grant
 - ✓ Any federal money received will be used only for educational purposes
