## **Barton's Transfer and Articulation Web Pages**

The <u>Barton transfer and articulation page</u> was recently re-worked by the PR team to align with KBOR (request for consistency in basic verbiage, icons etc.) to make transfer information more easily recognizable by student users.

When you click on one of the articulated courses, a pdf opens with a grid identifying the state public schools offering an equivalent course as well as the agreed upon Student Learning Outcomes.



At the bottom of the general page we link the Kansas State Department of Education <u>Statewide Agreements</u> for high school students pursuing occupational programs. We also provide a direct link to Program Assistant WTCE, as resource person for these CTE programs.
