











In fulfilling its educational mission, Barton Community College attempts to make optimal use of its resources. Optimum Utilization may call for the adjustment of operational procedures such as:

- **1. A reduction or discontinuance of a program or service**
- 2. Reallocation of resources as a result of changing educational priorities
- 3. Shifting enrollment patterns
- 4. Lack of funds and/or the requirements of legally imposed mandates

The President will make these recommendations to the Board of Trustees based on the College's mission of emphasizing academic, vocational-technical, and cultural enrichment learning opportunities; coupled with the need for maintaining program integrity, financial viability, and responsiveness to internal and external college constituencies.



Previous reports included a list of reports to the board and submissions to policy, funding, state, and local entities of factors which could cause changes. This information is closely duplicated in the <u>President's KBOR Update List</u> provided at each board meeting. This year we will concentrate on examples of contingency planning in action.
