If a credit or debit card is used, the payment will be electronically returned to the card. Other methods of payment will be returned via a check sent to the address listed on the student enrollment form.

### BUSINESS OFFICE POLICY

Students will be enrolled regardless of payment or non-payment and will not be dropped. The amount owed is the student's responsibility and the balance will remain on the student's account as a "hold" until payment is remitted.

### BOOST SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Students on free and/or reduced lunches are eligible for the Boost. For qualifying students, Boost will cover up to six hours of tuition and fees for face-to-face coursework per semester during an academic year (Fall, Spring, & Summer). Students will be held responsible for charges above six credit hours. Boost does not apply to program fees associated with Excel in CTE Initiative (SB155).

## 1. \*PRE-REQUISITE INFORMATION

**English Comp. I:** ASSET Writing Skills score of at least 40 or ACT English score of at least 17 or Accuplacer Writing Skills score of at least 69 or Compass Writing Skills score of at least 55 and ASSET Reading Skills score of at least 40 or ACT Reading score of at least 18 or Accuplacer Reading Skills score of at least 69 or Compass Reading Skills score of at least 75.

**College Algebra:** ACT Math Score of at least 23, Accuplacer Math score of at least 45, Intermediate Algebra ASSET score of at least 41.

**Certified Nurse Aide:** ASSET Reading Skills score of at least 35 or ACT Reading score of at least 14 or Accuplacer Reading score of 54 or a Compass Reading Skills score of at least 58. English Composition I with a "C" or better will also be accepted. A completed CNA enrollment packet, payment, and TB skin test must be submitted.

## 2. ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

**Tuesday, August 29<sup>th</sup> & Wednesday, August 30<sup>th</sup> from 11:00 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. over student's lunch period.**

- Parents welcome to visit to enroll.
- Students will need to know their Social Security Number or Barton ID to complete enrollment forms.
- Barton representatives will provide textbook information during enrollment.

## 3. PAYMENT INFORMATION

• **Pay in-person** at enrollment via **Cash, Check, Credit Card, or Money Order.**

- **Pay online** via Credit Card or NBS Payment Plan.



### Here's how to pay ONLINE:

- Notify the Barton representative at enrollment of how you plan to pay the tuition and fees for your class(es).
- Visit [mybarton.bartonccc.edu](http://mybarton.bartonccc.edu).
- Enter Barton ID number and PIN. Use Lookup ID if you don't know your Barton ID. Read the directions for PIN.
- Click on the PAWS logo.
- Chose the Student tab.
- To pay in full, select **Pay Online** and choose the Fall 2017 semester.
- To sign up for the payment plan, select **NBS Payment Plan** and follow the prompts to set it up.
  - ◆ Automatic bank payment (ACH)
  - ◆ There is a \$30 per semester non-refundable fee for participating in the payment plan.
  - ◆ Credit/Debit card payments will be processed on the 5th of each month until the balance is paid in full.
