April 2021	Soft Launch of new Essential Skills college wide project. "April Challenge" began with reporting back from faculty on use of Essential Skills in their classrooms. Prizes given through a drawing of all faculty that submitted information for the report.
May 2021	First college wide Essential Skills report compiled.
August 2021	Presentation on Essential Skills for college wide professional development at CougarTales.
September 2021	Launched college wide Essential Skills reporting project for 2021-2022 academic year.
