General Institutional Information:

- <u>Admissions Policies and Requirements</u> Explanation of Barton's admissions policies, including student types, graduation requirements and special admission programs.
- <u>Tuition and Fees Information</u> General cost per credit hour for various course delivery methods and various student distinctions.
- Student Activities Information about student activities offered by Barton
- Net Price Calculator This tool is delivered in compliance with Federal

- Regulations and can help students determine the overall cost (not direct cost) of attending Barton for one academic year.
- <u>Student Diversity</u> -Information regarding the makeup of Barton's diverse student body
- <u>Students' Rights under the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act</u>

 (FERPA) Information regarding Barton's policies established to protect student information and student privacy.
- <u>Student Concerns Procedure</u> An outline of various resolution, complaint and feedback systems available to our students.
- <u>Services and Facilities for Students with Disabilities</u> Information regarding services Barton provides to students with physical or learning disabilities in order to promote equal educational opportunities.
- <u>Voter Registration Information</u> Instructions students can follow to register to vote.
- <u>Constitution Day and Citizenship Day</u> Information regarding how Barton recognizes Constitution and Citizenship Day with its students, faculty and staff.
- Athletic Disclosures Barton's Equity in Athletics Disclosure Act Report including participation rates, financial support and other information on both men's and women's intercollegiate athletic programs.
- <u>Barton Mission and Vision</u> Barton's institutional vision and mission statements that direct all parts of college operations.

Academic Information:

- <u>Academic Warning Process</u> Requirements to meet the required academic and progress performance standards at Barton Community College.
- <u>Institutional Accreditation</u> Information regarding Barton's Institutional Accreditation and specific program accreditation.
- <u>Degree Options</u> A list of degrees that students can obtain through Barton, including the requirements for each.
- Academic Programs Listing A complete listing of all educational programs offered at Barton.
- Programs of Study with Degree Specifications A formatted listing of all

- educational programs offered at Barton including degree information and financial requirements.
- <u>Adult Basic Education Programs</u> Services offered through Barton's Center for Adult Education including GED classes and GED testing.
- <u>Barton's Campuses</u> A list of the campuses used by Barton to deliver programs.
- <u>Campus Directories</u> Employee directories, organizational charts and directories of institutional departments.
- <u>Transfer Credit Policies</u> Policies relevant to the transfer of credit hours to Barton from other institutions.
- <u>Textbook Information</u> A complete list of textbooks required for Barton courses including price and ISBN information.

Student Financial Aid Information:

- <u>Types of Financial Aid</u> Description of aid administered by Barton's Financial Aid Office.
- <u>Eligibility</u> Eligibility requirements for students to receive Title IV Federal Financial Aid.
- Applying for Financial Aid Step-by-step guide to completing the Free Application for Federal Aid (FAFSA) process with Barton.
- <u>Financial Aid Disbursement</u> Explanation of how Federal and other student aid is disbursed and distributed to students.
- <u>Rights</u> and <u>Responsibilities</u> of Students Receiving Aid Information pertinent to students receiving aid to understand their responsibilities for maintaining their eligibility and their rights to information regarding their aid.
- Cost of Attendance and Additional Program Costs An estimate of the total
 expenses for a student attending Barton Community College. The total figure
 includes tuition and fees, room and board (dorm and meal plan costs for an
 on campus student, or housing and food allowances for an off campus
 student), books, transportation, and miscellaneous expenses.
- <u>Student Loan Information</u> Pertinent information for student loan borrowers regarding student loan requirements, types of federal student loans and annual interest rates.
- Student Employment and Federal Work Study Information about student

- employment opportunities and payment rates.
- <u>Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy</u> Policy regarding the standard of academic achievement that must be maintained to remain eligible for financial aid.
- Refund and Return to Title IV Policies Procedures that Barton must follow when students fail to complete 100% of their enrolled coursework within a semester.
- <u>Financial Aid Employee Code of Conduct</u> Expectations for Barton Financial Aid staff members to adhere to in the administration all types of financial aid.
- Alternative Loan Code of Conduct Expectations for Barton Financial Aid staff members to adhere to with regard to private lenders and alternative student loans.

Health and Safety Information:

- Annual Security and Fire Safety Report Information regarding student safety and crimes reported on Barton's campuses and Annual fire safety reports. (In compliance with the Clery Act)
- <u>Missing Persons Policies</u> Policies and procedures to be followed by Barton Community College employees in the event that any person from campus is believed to be missing.
