IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ACADEMIC INTEGRITY COUNCIL



The Academic Integrity Council is approved by the President as an institutional team and a charter is established.

ICAI INSTITUTIONAL MEMBERSHIP



Barton becomes a member of the International Center of Academic Integrity (ICAI) to promote professional development.

PROCEDURE #2502 UPDATE & REVIEW



The update and restructure of the academic integrity policy and procedure begins and a sub-team is identified to begin the review. An annual review is established.

2019

NEW POSITION - DIRECTOR OF INNOVATION & COMPLIANCE



Director was added to the AI Council, later added to the procedure sub-team, and would serve as the primary AI investigator for capital violations.

ICAI 2019 CONFERENCE



Four AI Council members attended the international conference to identify trends, bring back new ideas, and clarify best practices. Conference participation is a general yearly practice.

AI VISUAL GRAPHICS



For more visibility, clarity of process, awareness, and marketing visual graphics were created including the AI flowchart and logo.

ACADEMIC INTEGRITY AWARENESS



Sub-team proposed shift to academic integrity (positive reinforcement) rather than just contract cheating and the consequences (negative reinforcement).

AI PROCEDURE APPROVAL & CONTINUED REVIEW

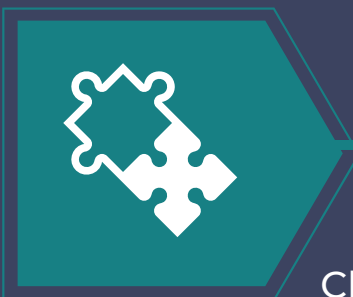
The AI procedure draft went through Faculty Council, Instructional Council, and Dean's Council and was approved by the President. Procedure review will continue as needed.

COVID - 19



Disruption paused progress during this time.

SUB-TEAM - INTEGRITY CAMPAIGN



Expansion of "Day of Action Against Contract Cheating" into a week-long academic integrity ('I Choose') campaign for student and faculty awareness and marketing information. This included the creation of Student Academic Integrity Ambassadors.

MAXIENT



Institutional software, Maxient, was implemented for academic integrity violation tracking.

2021



AI VISUAL GRAPHICS EXPANDED

AI visual resources were expanded and include an AI website development project, a Faculty Best Practices resource, and an updated Interactive Integrity Wheel to reflect and promote a culture of integrity beyond academics.

AI PROCESS FACULTY PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT



Presentations/recordings were provided to inform and educate faculty on the new academic integrity violation process as well as provide student education and resources.

COURSE SYLLABUS AI STATEMENT



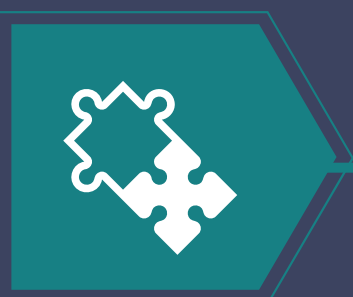
A academic integrity course syllabus statement was proposed and later approved by LICC.

STUDENT AI PRESENTATIONS



Student seminars, orientation (basic and departmental) presentations were provided to students to clarify type of cheating and provide tips and resources to help make a different decision.

AI CAMPAIGN EXPANSION



The "I Choose" AI Campaign was expanded into an academic fair, which opened engagement and participation to local K-12, college students, and faculty. AI student seminars were also provided.

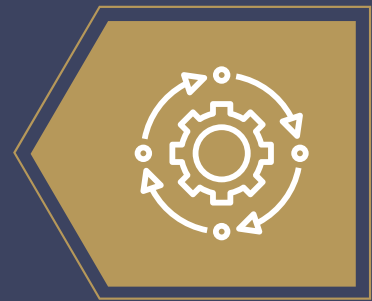


AI ORIENTATION FOR NEW FACULTY

Through the investigation of new capital cases, additional information was learned and applied to improve the process and be data driven.



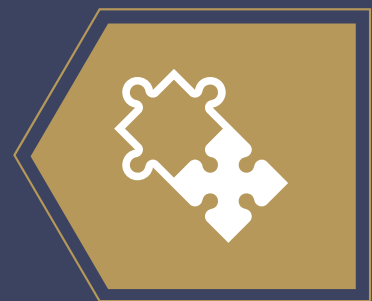
AI DATA REVIEW & TRENDS

With a growing collection of AI data and a new increase in AI violations, a review of AI data and an analysis to identify trends is currently in progress.
