- Dance Studio Barton's dance studio, Studio 34, is a large space with program-enhancing features. The studio includes Stagestep flooring, high ceilings, comfortable air conditioning/heating units, a stereo system, multiple ballet barres, balance boards, and lots of room to dance.
- Dorothy Moses Morrison Chapel The chapel is an ideal setting for solo recitals, small chamber groups, and public performances. It also serves as the Choral Room for the Barton Music Department. The room is equipped with an organ, upright piano, and Steinway grand piano.
- Fine Arts Auditorium Renovated in 2013, the Auditorium is the primary venue for performing arts events, guest lectures, and community events throughout the year. The auditorium seats 632 guests.
- L. E. "Gus" and Eva Shafer Memorial Art Gallery Located in the Fine Arts building, the Shafer Gallery displays significant works by Gus Shafer, objects from Barton's growing permanent collection, and a rotating series of exhibitions from regional and national artists. As the only art gallery in the county, the instructional activities and collections are designed to meet the needs of all age groups.
