 The institution engages in ongoing assessment of <u>student learning</u> as part of its commitment to the educational outcomes of students




### **HLC Criterion 4B**

- 1. The institution has <u>effective processes</u> for assessment of student learning and for achievement of goals in academic and cocurricular activities
- 2. The institution <u>uses the information gained from</u> assessment to <u>improve student learning</u>
- 3. The institution's processes and methodologies to assess student learning reflect good practice, including the <u>substantial participation</u> of faculty, instructional, and other relevant staff members

### **Course Competencies**

- Faculty have always been required to teach and assess all of the stated competencies in a given syllabus
- A given course is simply the totality of all of its competencies

#### Fall 2021

- Faculty will now be required to document student learning based on the competencies in ONE course
- Faculty will need to submit results for two different competencies – one that could be deemed a strength and another that could be deemed a weakness
- Link to a form will be emailed to faculty as the Fall 2021 semester ends
