Retention and program completion are industry standards for evaluating the success of students as is evidenced by the requirement to report these metrics to The Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS: <https://nces.ed.gov/collegenavigator/?q=Barton&s=all&id=154697>)

Retention

This is the percentage of first-time degree/certificate-seeking students from the previous fall who either re-enrolled or successfully completed their program by the current fall. Also as part of the Student Success Academy work, the Barton Academy Team is working with Barton's Office of Institutional Effectiveness to develop a robust data map that will track a variety of student success metrics for various Barton student populations annually.

Success Rate

The Student Success Academy also measured "Success Rate" by course completers who earn A, B or C grades. Unsuccessful rate is course completers who earned D or F grades. Click on the image below to view the full size info graphic!

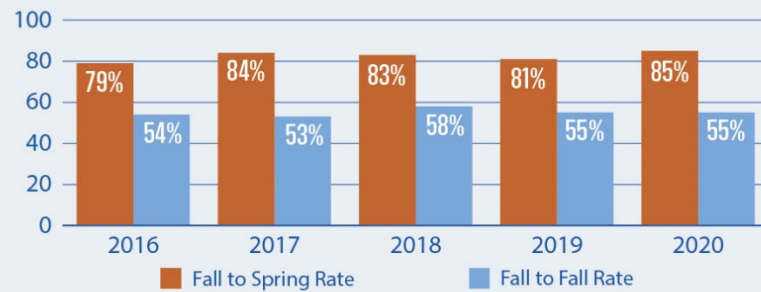

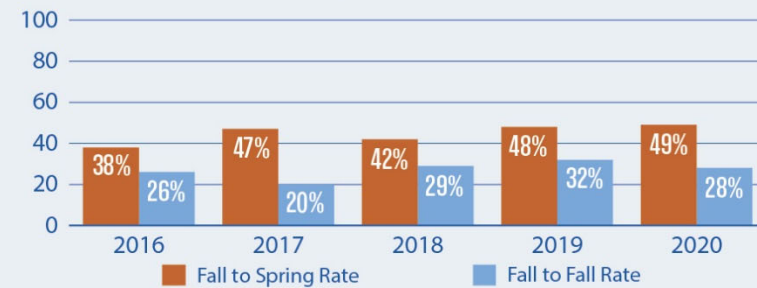

Retention | Part time



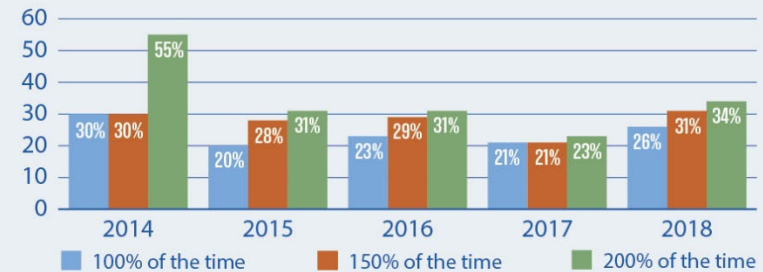
The retention rate is percentage of first-time degree seeking students from the previous fall who either re-enrolled or successfully completed their program by the current fall.

Course Success Rate



Course Success Rate: course completers who earned A, B or C grades
 Unsuccessful Rate: course completers who earned D or F grades

Program Completion



The program completion rate is the percentage of IPEDS first-time, full-time degree-seeking cohort students who completed their program in 100%, 150%, or 200% of "normal time."
