General Game Notes:

- Barton owns a 26-8 edge over the Lady Grizzlies at the Barton Gym, with Butler's last victory coming Feb 13, 2010 when Butler won 76-73.
- Overall, Barton leads the series 51-17 and has a current four game win streak against the Lady Grizzlies.

About the Lady Cougars:

- After last Monday's victory over Dodge City in the christening of Fleske Court, Barton has a four game home winning streak and a five game home conference game winning streak.
- Freshman Ashton Bruner is the only Lady Cougar to average in double-digit scoring (10.8) as five Lady Cougars average 8 or more points.
- Bruner also leads the Lady Cougars in both rebounds and steals and has recorded two double-double performances this year. Bruner ranks 14th in the West in scoring 10.5, 4th in the West in rebounds (8.0), and 9th in steals (2.3).
- In Barton's 62-44 loss at Garden City Wednesday night, Blair Bloomfield (12 points) and Erin Copeland (11 points) were the only Lady Cougars to score in double-figures.
- Sophomore Blair Bloomfield sits just below scoring in double-figures (9.8). Bloomfield has three career double-double performances with her last one coming in Barton's 74-63 Nov 9th win over Kansas Wesleyan JV in which she scored 18 points and grabbed a career high 12 rebounds.

About the Lady Grizzlies:

- After a stellar high school career at Marion High School, Head Coach Mike Helmer played collegiate hoops at Pratt Community College and then at Kansas Wesleyan University.
- Butler has played the toughest conference schedule thus far dropping a 86-84 game at #10 Garden City then a 58-45 loss at home against #1 Hutchinson
- Wednesday's loss to Hutch was the first of the year at home for Butler after seven straight wins.
- Sophomore Jamillah Bonner, leads the Lady Grizzlies in points (19.7 points), rebounds (9.7), and steals (3.8). Against Hutch Wednesday she had 5 points, 10 rebounds, and 2 steals.
- Bonner, who has already signed to play at Wichita State University, was a 1st Team All-Conference and 2nd Team All-Region selection last year and selected to play in the NJCAA All-Star Weekend this summer,
- Freshman Ashlee Ivy leads the team in field goal percentage at 55%.

General Game Notes:

- Barton owns a 27-17 edge over the Grizzlies at the Barton Gym, with Butler's last victory at Barton coming January 17, 2011 when Butler won 81-77 in overtime.
- Overall, Barton leads the series 49-37 with Barton sweeping the games last year. Butler last swept the season series in 2010 season.
- In last year's 74-67 Barton win on Feb 15 at the Barton gym, the game marked only the second and only times the Cougars won a conference game without scoring 80 points. Their other conference win was also against Butler when Barton won 71-62 at Butler.

About the Cougars:

- Wednesday night the Cougars suffered their first conference loss of the season in losing 66-47 at Garden City. The 47 points were the fourth lowest scored by Barton in modern history.
- The Cougars lead the Jayhawk West conference in several statistical categories: Scoring, Margin of Victory, Steals, and Assist-to-Turnover Ratio.
- Barton has three players averaging double figures and three more averaging close or over eight points per game.
- Sophomore and '12 third team All-American Algie Key ranks 2nd in the West averaging 18.9 points a game and 4th best in the West in assists (4.0/game). Key was also named the KJCCC player of the week last week.
- Despite a subpar performance Wednesday night at Garden, freshman Raheem Johnson continues to improve. Johnson ranks 5th in the West in rebounding (7.8/game) and 2nd in blocks (2.3/game)
- Sophomore Andell Cumberbatch is scoring nearly 15 points per game and recorded his second career double-double last Saturday night vs Seward scoring 15 points and 10 rebounds.
- Sophomore Turon Parker ranks 6th in the West in steals (3.9/game).

About the Grizzlies:

Mike Bargaen has led the Grizzlies to three 17+ victories in his first five complete seasons. He is the son of former Hutchinson CC head coach Gary Bargaen (1978-86). Bargaen led the Grizzlies to the Jayhawk and Region VI Championships and qualified them for the NJCAA National Tournament for only the 4th time in school history.

- Butler had a 9 game winning streak snapped Wednesday night and their first home loss of the season falling 81-67 to Hutch.
- Butler is ranked #1 in the Western Conference in Field Goal % and also in 3-pt Field Goal % Defense. They are shooting 50% from the field while only allowing opponents to shoot 27.8% from behind the arc.
- Butler has four players qualify in the top ten in the Western Conference for Field Goal Percentage. Jordan Madrid-Andrews is 2nd at 64.6%, Trent Richardson is ranked 3rd at 63.7%, LaMont Pruitt is 5th at 58.7%, while Eric Watson rounds out the top ten at 10th best shooting 54.1%.
- Even though Butler is leading the Conference in Field Goal Percentage, they don't have any players ranked in the top ten of the Western Conference in scoring. However, they do have six players averaging 7 points or more a game.
- Grizzly leading scorer Sean Osler scored 16 & 17 points against the Cougars last year.
