In five seasons at Barton, Coach Twelvetrees teams are an incredible 62-1-2 in Region VI play, his teams have broken every school record possible with an overall re-

cord of 96-13-4 at .85 Win %. This season the team had the best season in school history coming $3^{\rm rd}$ at the National . He has guided the men's soccer program to Jayhawk Conference titles in 2007, 2008 & 2010 and Region VI titles in 2007, 2008 & 2010. In 2008, Barton set several school records including finishing the season as the only undefeated team in the Nation with a 20-0-2 record,

This year Barton saw its first player signed by an MLS club when Kevin Ellis inked a homegrown player contract with Sporting KC. Kevin came to Barton in 2009 was a two –time All American and is he first ever player to go directly from a Junior College into the MLS.

With Coach Twelvetrees at the helm of the men's soccer program, Barton have been ranked as high as #2 in the nation for a school record 4 weeks and finished in the Top 10 in the NSCAA & NJCAA ranking in each of the last 5 years. Another remarkable streak is the fact hat Twelvetrees has coached at least one All American every year with a total of eight in five years. As well as coaching the KJCCC Freshman & Player of the Year in 2008, 2009 & 2010.

Perhaps Coach Twelvetrees biggest accomplishment is recruiting 30 players between 2006-2010 onto NCAA DI, D2 and NAIA four year universities. Coach Twelvetrees was named KJCCC Coach of the Year in 2007, 2008, & 2010. NSCAA Regional Coach of the Year in 2009 & 2010.

Twelvetrees came to Barton from Wayne State (Neb) College, where he led team to 1st winning record in 4 years this season and was listed among the Top 15 most improved schools in the NCAA. Prior to his stint at Wayne State, Twelvetrees was an assistant at Bemidji State University (MN) where he earned his Master's degree in Sports Science. He also currently serves as the Associate Director of Coaching for KYSA and Head ODP Coach of 94 boys in Kansas.
