

Barton Volleyball is nationally recognized as one of the top NJCAA programs in the nation. The Cougars are the 2003 National Champions, and have played in the national tournament over 20 times. The Cougars rank 1st in the nation in national semi-final appearances and in total number of First Team All-Americans and Academic All-Americans. Barton leads the NJCAA in First Team All-Americans, placing 25 over the years. Barton has also won 16 straight Regional Champion-



ships from 1988-2003. The Cougars have won all but six Jayhawk West Titles since 1982.
