* Though many instructors participate themselves, they tend not to utilize all the available functions provided for online education. I would like to see taped classroom instruction, or the ability for students to view a live lecture and participate via chat, and or voice also like to see the instructors use the chat features allowing more interaction. Many people find this a failing and don't like online requirement that the student be a self starter. If there are blocks of time where the student knows they can go to participate and hear a real lecture; or be able to speak live with the instructor during a chat discussion session, many more people may find it a fuller experience.

* I don't really see the need for any changes at this time. The website is great and easy to use. The program that is used for taking tests is outstanding! It ensures that the computer is dedicated to the test at hand while keeping the test taker from browsing and searching for answers. Prior to taking the test I wondered how the test process would work, I was pleased to see and utilize the program.
