

# CCAMPIS Grant Guidelines

## Application Instructions

**\*\*IMPORTANT\*\***

Read instructions before completing application. Incomplete applications will be returned to the student for completion. Students applying for the Child Care Access Grant must complete this application and return to the Barton Child Development Center. Applications must be completed in ink or typed.

**The Child Care Access Means Parents In School (CCAMPIS) program is federal grant funded by the U.S. Department of Education to support student-parents.**

### Guidelines

The purpose of this agreement is to communicate an understanding of your responsibilities while attending Barton County Community College and participating in the CCAMPIS grant program. We believe students should be aware of their responsibilities before agreeing to participate in the program. Thus, we request you carefully read this agreement before signing the application.

1. Applicants must be receiving a Pell grant and have a high school transcript or GED on file with Enrollment Services at the time of your enrollment at Barton County Community College.
2. Applicant's children must be attending the Barton County Community College Child Development Center.
3. Applicants must be enrolled in Barton County Community College courses.
4. Applicants may be full-time or part-time students. Part-time students must register for at least 6 credit hours.
5. **The grant recipient will be required to comply with the rules and regulations of the Barton Child Development Center. Grant recipients will be required to participate in a minimum of 6 hours in the Parent Advisory Committee or Parent Organization Meetings/Events.**
6. Applicants must reapply for the CCAMPIS grant every semester. Maximum renewal for this grant money is two times a year, once in the fall and spring semesters.
7. Grant recipients will be notified of acceptance within 30 days of receipt of application. If approved, the grant will start at the beginning of the awarded month, and is not retroactive to a previous month(s).
8. The following is the formula of payments per child:  
  
6-8 credit hours = \$49 per child per month  
9-11 credit hours = \$74 per child per month  
12+ credit hours = \$99 per child per month  
(If at any time during the semester you drop classes your payments will decrease accordingly.)
