Awards: The Barton Foundation and the Shafer Gallery will be giving selected scholarships to award winning artists.

Director's Choice Award: \$500 scholarship

Best in Show 2D: \$500 scholarship Best in Show 3D: \$500 scholarship

Entry Limits: Each teacher may submit up to 25 works. Please be selective with 3-D art as the gallery has limited space.

Entry Forms— **Art teachers** should fill out the loan and inventory form.

Entries: 2-Dimensional

- -Must be matted and ready for hanging.
- -Use Velcro as a hanging device for all matted work. Use Velcro on the corners and center.
- -Paintings, however, should be wired on the back for hanging.
- -Framing is not required but simple wooden strips nailed directly to the sides of the stretcher bars are suggested.

I.D. tags: Using the forms provided, make two tags for each entry. Attach one tag securely to the back of the work. Attach a second tag to the front with a piece of masking tape.

Lunch: We will provide pizza for the students and we will eat together in the

Fine Arts Building.

Check Out: You may pick up work any time after May 5th during regular operating hours, Monday through Saturday 10 am to 5 pm. You may also take work with you on May 5th.

Painting: Acrylic and Oil
