DIRECTOR'S NOTE

The world around us is an ever-changing landscape of ideologies, ideas, thoughts and desires. We are frequently bombarded with beliefs that clash with our own. *Time Stands Still* invites us to look unflinchingly at the ways we navigate love, morality, and meaning in a world defined by conflict. As a director, I'm drawn to how the play balances intimacy and global awareness. Within the walls of a single apartment, Margulies explores the collisions between art and ethics, empathy and exhaustion, love and independence. Every conversation between these characters crackles with tension—not because they're cruel, but because they care deeply. They wrestle with the same contradictions that face anyone who tries to live consciously in a chaotic world: How do we keep bearing witness without being broken by what we see? How do we love without losing ourselves?

This production aims to honor that complexity. The stillness of Sarah's camera lens becomes a metaphor for our own need to pause—to look, to feel, to decide what kind of people we will be when time seems to stand still.
