

Dear Prospective Student,

Thank you for your interest in the Barton Practical Nursing Program. The purpose of this letter is to share information about the program and help you with the application process. Our website has valuable information including the step by step guide for applying to our program.

The Practical Nursing Program is a two semester program. Upon completion of the program our students will receive a certificate and are eligible to take the national licensure examination (NCLEX-PN) to become a Licensed Practical Nurse.

Covid-19 Statement: Currently, the Barton Nursing Program does not require Covid-19 vaccination as an entrance requirement. Be advised that Covid-19 vaccination may be required in the future due to the increasing number of clinical sites requiring students to be vaccinated. Acceptance of Religious and Medical exemptions will be at the discretion of each clinical site.

- To request an application, complete the PN application intent form and e-mail Carla Enstrom at enstromc@bartonccc.edu
- The Nursing Program Application is due January 31, 2022 along with 3 letters of recommendation.
- You can apply to the program while completing your pre-requisite courses, but course work must be completed by May 31st.
- Admission into the nursing program will be based on a selection process and those who are accepted will be notified by March 30, 2022. Acceptance form with \$100.00 fee will be due by Aug 10th.
- Completing our program does NOT guarantee licensure as the Kansas State Board of Nursing has stringent requirements. If you have a misdemeanor or felony conviction of a crime against a person, you may not be eligible. If you have questions about a conviction, please contact the Kansas State Board of Nursing Legal Department at 785-296-4929.

Nursing Pre-Application Step-By-Step Guide

Step #1 - Complete Barton's online Admissions Application (link on Nursing webpage)

- o If you already know your Barton ID#, you can skip this step.
 - If it has been longer than 6 months since your last class, you will need to reapply OR
 - Complete the Change of Major form
- After submission, you will receive an email with acceptance and your Barton ID# from admissions within
 24-48 hrs. This will go to the email you registered on the application.
- o If you do not receive an email within that timeframe, you will need to contact admissions. admissions@bartonccc.edu or 620-792-9286.
- Once you select Nursing as your major on the admissions application, please reach out to your assigned pre-nursing advisor. (This may take up to 2-3 business days)

☐ Step #2 – Transcripts:

 - She will help evaluate college credits or advise into upcoming classes

- You will need to have all college transcripts sent directly to Barton Enrollment Services. These need to be **official transcripts** or they will not be accepted. Once received and transferred in, we will review to let you know your status regarding pre-requisites.
 - If you are currently or will be finishing any pre requisites at an institution outside of Barton, please do not order your official transcript to be sent until after your final grade(s) have been posted to your transcript, to avoid having to pay for multiple transcripts.
 - If taking or have taken credits at Barton, you do not need to order an official transcript, as we already have access to that information.
- You will also need to have your official high school transcript sent in as well to the same below address.

Any course to be considered for acceptance must be completed by May 31. If you will not meet this
deadline, you will need to request an extension with the Director of Nursing.

☐ Step #4 – Placement Test

- Applicants for the PN level must meet a minimum math requirement for admission to the nursing program at BCC, exhibited by at least one of the following:
 - TEAS Math score of 50 or higher
 - ACT Math score of 21 or higher
 - Completion of Basic Algebra with a grade of a "C" or better OR 8 modules in College Preparatory Math (CPM)
 - Accuplacer NG Math score 250 or higher
- If a student does not meet the minimum Math requirement, they must first complete Math modules 1-8 in College Preparatory Math.

Step #5 − Nursing Pre-Requisites:

- Pre-requisite Courses required for admission into the Practical Nursing (PN) program:
 - Anatomy & Physiology (taken within last 5 yrs)...5 credit hours
 - General Psychology3 credit hours
 - Developmental Psychology3 credit hours
 - English Composition I3 credit hours
 - Public Speaking or IPC......3 credit hours

o KS Certified Nurse Aide Certificate (CNA)

- A current KS Certified Nurse Aide certificate is required to be accepted into the Practical Nursing (PN) Program.
- Barton offers CNA courses year round. Please contact Adult Healthcare office for more information, enrollment or questions.

Step #6 – TEAS (link on webpage) If you have not previously completed in the last 3 years.

- The test covers math, science, reading, vocabulary and grammar. Contact the nursing office for more information. This test is given at least twice a month from September to January and must be taken prior to the end of January. You may take the test up to 3 times within a calendar year, with a 30 day wait period between tests. A minimum score of 58.7 is required.

- \$70.00 paid to the Barton Business Office
- Receipt submitted to Nursing to receive admissions ticket

☐ Step #7— Legal Issues

- Being convicted of certain crimes may prevent you from being licensed by the Kansas State Board of Nursing.

- Applications to the nursing program are evaluated on the following:
 - Complete nursing application by the priority deadline of Jan 31st of the year you want to enter the program.
 - Secondary deadline March 1.
 - Overall College GPA
 - o needs to be 2.5 or greater
 - GPA of pre-requisites required for the nursing program
 - o needs to be 3.0 or greater
 - Completion of Pre-requisite courses.
 - Current KS CNA certificate required for PN applicants only.
 - Entrance test (ATI TEAS Test) score required. Minimum score of 58.7 required.
 - (Required for both PN and RN programs)
 - Professionalism
 - All coursework, for full acceptance, must be completed by May 31st. Coursework completed after May 31 will not be evaluated for candidate acceptance.
 - Three <u>signed</u> letters of endorsement
