There are three choices when needing to take the TEAS test:

- 1) Test in Great Bend, KS at Barton Community College
- 2) Test in Pratt, KS at Pratt Community College

Planning to test in Great Bend:

All TEAS tests are in the Assessment Center located in the north end of the Learning Resource Center (middle of campus) and start at 1:00 p.m. on each date listed below. A photo ID and admission ticket are required for admission into the test. Doors close at 1:00pm and we will not accept late entrance.

1. Please complete the online registration form located on the Nursing webpage <https://www.bartonccc.edu/programs/nursing>.
2. The cost of the test is \$70, payable to the Barton Community College Business Office (cash, check or card).
 - a. Please call the Business Office (620-786-7463) OR stop into the Business Office in the upper level of the Kirkman Bldg. (West side of campus) to make payment. (Pay before the day of the test to allow time to receive your admission ticket via your provided email.)
 - b. Your spot is not secure until your \$70 fee is paid to the business office.
 - c. You can email a copy of your receipt, to Jennifer Tusten at tustenj@bartonccc.edu, or ask the Business Office to send a copy of the receipt to the Nursing Department.
 - d. Upon confirmation of payment, your admission ticket will be emailed to you at the email address provided at registration. You will present the admission ticket on testing day.
3. The test is taken in the Assessment Center. A photo ID and admission ticket are required for admission into the test.
4. You must give 24 hours' notice, prior to the test, to change the test date or you forfeit the cost of the test, and you will have to repay to sign up for another test date.
5. If you are not satisfied with your test score you may retake the test 3 times/ calendar year. There must be at least 30 days between test dates.

6. If you need your test score sent to another college you will need to make sure you put that school in before taking the test and a \$25 service fee will be charged.
7. If you have taken the TEAS test at another college other than Barton, then you will need to have your scores sent, via transcript from ATI to the Barton Nursing Department by Jan. 31st.
8. The test time limit is 3 1/2 hrs. for 170 multiple choice questions. Calculators may NOT be used for the test.

Go to the ATI TEAS website <https://www.atitesting.com/teas/register>

1. Choose **Proctored by ATI** to register. The cost of the test is \$120.
2. You will need to have a physical copy of your government-issued ID (U.S. State or Territory Issued Driver's License or ID Card, U.S. Passport or U.S. Passport Card, U.S. Military ID, U.S. Permanent Resident Card, U.S. Visa, or Foreign Government Issued Passport).
3. You will not be able to use any notes, books, etc. while taking the exam at home. There are also study helps with ATI that you can purchase to help you prepare for the exam.
4. ATI has a strict rescheduling policy.
5. One free transcript is included with your exam registration. However, transcript submissions to schools vary by how you take your TEAS exam. Please send them to Barton Community College.

Barton Community College Study for the ATI TEAS Test

The ATI TEAS assesses the academic preparedness of entry-level nursing students in Reading, Math, Science, and English and Language Usage. An ATI TEAS® Study Manual and online practice assessments are available for the students to use for preparation and review <https://www.atitesting.com/teas/teas-prep>. Make sure you study for the ATI TEAS test. If you took a different version of the TEAS test you will have to take the ATI TEAS test.

When taking the ATI TEAS, students will demonstrate reading skills in paragraph comprehension, passage comprehension, and inferences and conclusions. The math section will measure their knowledge of whole numbers, metric conversion, fractions and decimals, algebraic application, percentages, ratio and proportion, and data interpretation. Science covers scientific reasoning, life science, chemical science, physical science, human body science, and general science. And in the English section, students will tackle punctuation, grammar, sentence structure, contextual words, and spelling.
