EXCEL IN CTE INITIATIVE (SB155) OPPORTUNITIES

Changes Effective Fall 2026 Semester

Changes are due to 2026 House Bill 2513 [Section 114(a)]

Kansas high school juniors and seniors who meet below requirements can take specific career technical courses tuition-free.

Students are responsible for textbooks and/or materials, if applicable.

As of the **Fall 2026 Semester**, these requirements apply for students to take these classes tuition-free:

- Must be a junior or senior enrolled in a Kansas high school
- Have a 2.0 or higher high school GPA and a transcript on file with the College
- Be on track to graduate from a Kansas high school

These details will be verified with the student's school officials. Students who do not meet the requirements, or cannot be verified, **can take classes but will be charged tuition and fees.**

The tuition-free list is set by the Kansas Board of Regents and is subject to change with little or no notice. Barton Community College does not decide which classes are tuition free.

Each Kansas college has a different list of approved classes, so please pay attention to what is covered at each separate college when enrolling. Some classes that were previously covered are no longer covered.

Excel in CTE eligible courses, both online and on-site, qualify for funding as long as students meet the above details. Appropriate majors will be connected to students' accounts.

Students who fail or have failed an Excel in CTE course cannot receive funding to retake the course. Students who fail or have failed two Excel in CTE courses cannot receive funding for any other Excel in CTE courses.
