SENATE BILL #155 LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES

"Tuition waived for high school students thanks to new state legislation"

The Kansas Senate passed Senate Bill 155 in May 2012. This bill authorizes the state of Kansas to pay tuition charges for any tiered Career Technical courses. Courses designated as SB155-eligible will be available to high school students at no cost except textbook and program fees (if applicable)>

The following career technical education courses, both online and onsite, qualify under the bill's framework. This means students can take advantage of classes with NO TUITION CHARGED.

Textbooks and program fees may apply.
