SOME THINGS TO BE AWARE OF:

The College sends rosters of enrolled students to high school administration for authorization of attendance. Administration is only verifying that the student is at least a sophomore or older in the classroom that he or she has reported.

Unified School Districts have complete approval over **dual** credit partnerships and the awarding or not awarding of high school credit for college classes. Check with a district or high school official prior to enrollment.

What this means: You will **always** get college credit for the class that you take with Barton, but how you earn or don't earn high school credit for a Barton class is determined by your USD.

HOW TO GET STARTED: PARTNERED ONLINE

Discuss this option with your counselor OR contact Karly Little, who will then contact your counselor.

The semester dates and mentor support must come from the school.

Once this connection is made, your child/child's counselor will work to complete the correct electronic and paper steps to enroll.

Tuition/fees are due in full by the conclusion of the semester. The current tuition rate is \$118 per credit hour, \$354 for the classes currently offered in this format.

Payment options: online, by mail, or by phone—partial or full payments with no penalty.

BARTonline

No restrictions on counties of residence.

16 sessions over the course of a calendar year.

Build these classes into your high school day or take them on your own time.

General Education and Career Technical Education classes offered online each session.

HOW TO GET STARTED: BARTONLINE

Discuss this option with your family.

IF the student plans to take the class during the high school day, he or she needs approval to put it in their schedule at the high school. Students may take online classes on their own time without this approval at most districts.

Visit bartonccc.edu

Choose ONLINE on the blue bar across the top

Fill out the Admissions application

Receive your Barton ID number via email

Sign in to the My Barton Portal > PAWS to search for classes and enroll

Tuition/fees are due in full by the conclusion of the semester. The current tuition rate is \$150 per credit hour, unless the class is on the Excel in CTE list of offerings.

Payment options: online, by mail, or by phone—partial or full payments with no penalty.

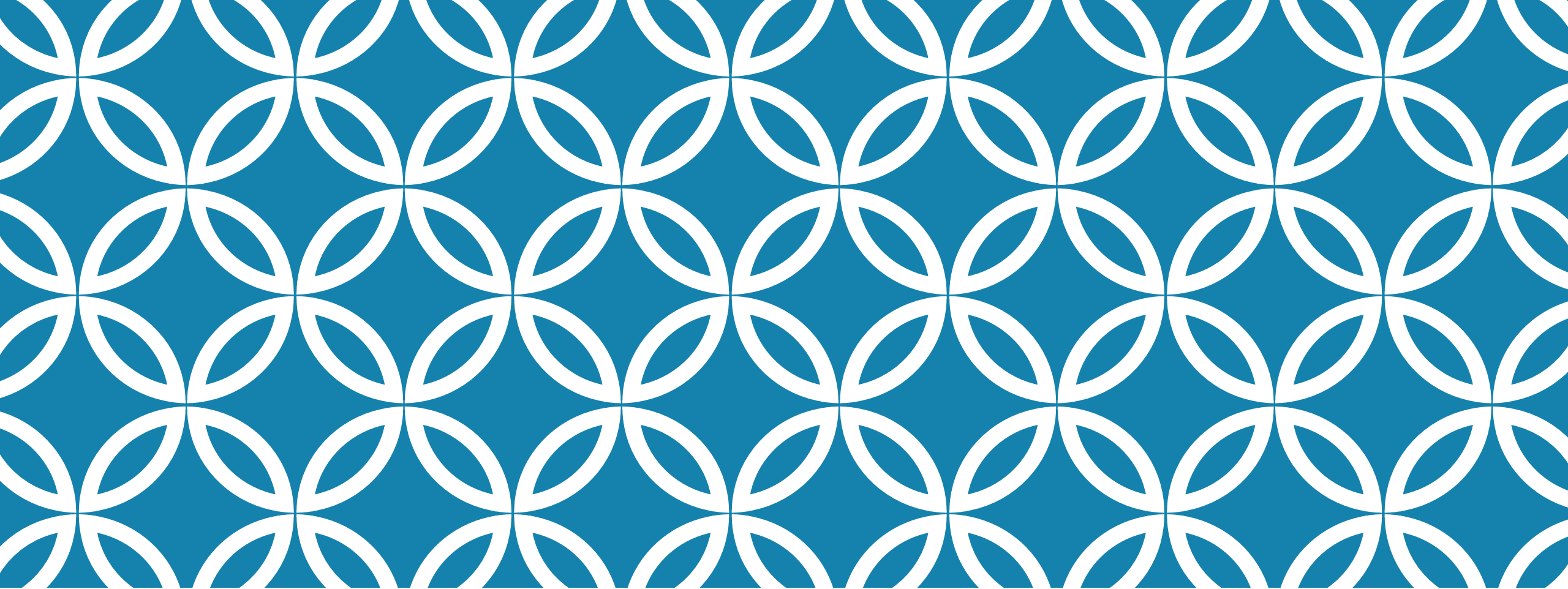
