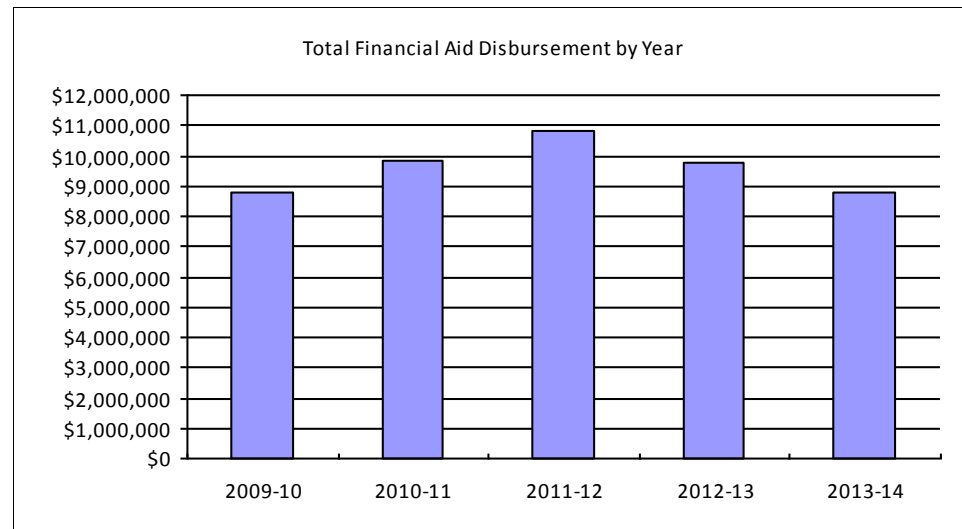

Barton Financial Aid Facts --

- The average financial aid package offered to Barton students for 13-14 was \$5,522, which was a combination of federal, state, institutional and other aid.
- The largest financial aid award paid to a Barton student in 13-14 was \$17,035.
- 100% of Barton county 2013 high school graduates received some type of financial aid in 2013-14.
- 77% of the Federal Aid applicants (FAFSA) processed for 13-14 were eligible for a Federal Pell Grant. 56% of the applicants were eligible for the maximum Pell of \$5,645.
- 16% of students taking at least one BartOnline class received financial aid, VA or Tuition Assistance (or a combination).
