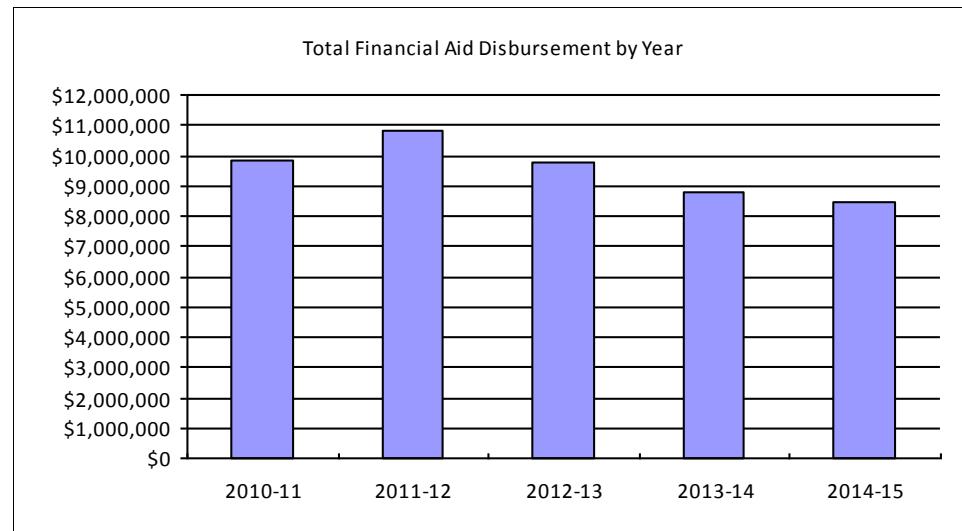

Barton Financial Aid Facts --

- The average financial aid package offered to Barton students for 14-15 was \$5,900, which was a combination of federal, state, institutional and other aid.
- The largest financial aid award paid to a Barton student in 14-15 was \$16,646.
- 100% of Barton county 2014 high school graduates received some type of financial aid in 2014-15.
- 67% of the Federal Aid applicants (FAFSA) processed for 14-15 were eligible for a Federal Pell Grant. 62% of the applicants were eligible for the maximum Pell of \$5,730.
- 31% of students taking at least one BartOnline class received financial aid, VA or Tuition Assistance (or a combination).
