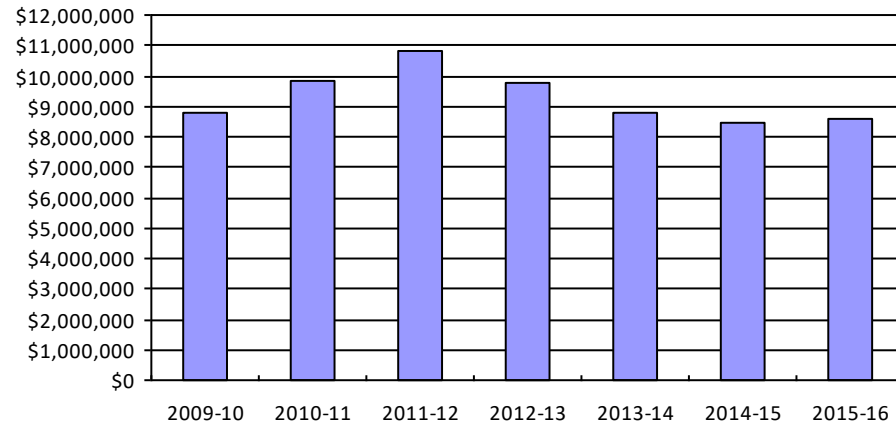

Barton Financial Aid Facts --

- The average financial aid package offered to Barton students for 15-16 was \$6,742, which was a combination of federal, state, institutional and other aid.
- The largest financial aid award paid to a Barton student in 15-16 was \$22,759.
- 100% of Barton county 2015 high school graduates received some type of financial aid in 2015-16.
- 75% of the Federal Aid applicants (FAFSA) processed for 15-16 were eligible for a Federal Pell Grant. 48% of the applicants were eligible for the maximum Pell of \$5,775.
- 30% of students taking at least one BARTonline class received financial aid, VA or Tuition Assistance (or a combination).
