#### **PAYMENT:**

Soldiers should be eligible for tuition assistance (TA) prior to enrolling with Barton. All students can enroll by selecting PAWS in their Barton Portal or visiting the Barton office.

## IMPORTANT NOTICE

#### for the TA user:

TA covers the tuition (\$130/credit hour). The soldier is responsible for any listed fees which must be paid by the end of the semester.

## **College Program Frequently Asked Questions:**

#### What does hybrid mean?

o Hybrid means that a portion of the courses are in class and a portion of the courses are online.

#### • How much do the courses cost?

o These courses are \$130 per credit hour.

#### • When is payment due for the courses?

o Payment is due for these courses by the end of the semester. For example, if you are taking classes in the Fall semester, the payment will not be due until December. The full amount for courses must be paid before you can take any courses in the Spring semester. Until the balance is paid in full, a hold will be placed on your final grades and transcripts.

#### • Where do I get my books?

o For the In-Person enrollments, Instructors will sign-out books to the students on the first night of class. The books must be returned to the instructor at the end of the cycle or if the class is dropped. For the LiveOnline enrollments, students will receive an email near the start date of the class containing information for the book check-out. If the book is not returned, then a charge will be placed on your account and you will no longer be able to take classes until you return the book or pay for it.

#### How often do the classes run?

 Classes are held for 8 weeks at a time and there are five cycles a year. There are two 8-week cycles in the Spring and Fall semesters and there is one 8-week cycle in the Summer semester.

#### What days of the week are classes held?

 The classes are held 1-2 nights a week between Monday and Friday for 3 hours. The day for each class does vary each cycle, you will need to look at a schedule to determine the day of your class. Any holidays for the cycle are also posted on the schedule\*

#### • If I am a civilian, can I take these courses even though they are held on Fort Leavenworth?

 Anyone can take the night courses, you do not need to be affiliated with the military in order to attend.

#### Can my high school child take these classes?

Yes as long as the child is in the summer of their sophomore year.

#### • When will the next schedule be out?

• The college program class schedules are usually released 1 week after the previous cycle has started.

#### If I am active duty, will Tuition Assistance (TA) pay for the full cost of the course?

Tuition Assistance will cover the full cost of tuition (\$130 per credit hour) for the course. If using TA, the soldier will only be responsible for any listed fees for the course (ex. Lab fee). The soldier will not have to purchase a book for the class because Barton provides them. If you are utilizing TA, then it must be requested the day before the class is first scheduled to meet.
