If I don't already have one will I receive an ID card? Prior to your effective date you will receive a new Benefit Management, LLC health plan card. There is an ELIXIR logo on this card. Show this card to your pharmacist when you get a prescription filled.

Where can I fill my prescriptions?

Retail Pharmacies. To find out which pharmacies participate, you can log onto our website at www.elixirsolutions.com Register using the ELIXIR information on your ID card and click on pharmacy locator. Our website includes the ability to search for participating pharmacies, research drug alternatives, and print a history of your prescription claims. (Please note that due to the HIPAA law, members 18 years of age and older must each register separately.) Please call ELIXIR for any assistance in this process at 800-771-4648.

Will I pay more if I choose to fill a Brand drug when a Generic equivalent is available? Yes. If you have a Brand prescription filled when a Generic equivalent is available, you will pay the Brand Copay, plus the difference in cost between the Brand and the Generic drug. This Plan encourages the use of Generic drugs because in most cases Generics are just as effective as Brands and much less expensive. Please ask your physician and your pharmacist to prescribe and dispense Generic drugs whenever possible.

What is Step Therapy:

Step Therapy is a program designed for members to start with the most cost-effective and safest medication before progressing to more costly or risky therapies. With Step Therapy, members are required to take a Step One medication before trying a Step Two medication. For more information, call 800-771-4648 and speak to a pharmacy benefit advisor.

BIC Align Program:

The *BIC Align Program* is designed to reduce Prescription Drug out-of-pocket expense for the Covered Person and Plan costs on certain Specialty Drugs at "BIC" (best in class) Specialty Pharmacies by maximizing manufacturer Co-pay assistance for conditions requiring Specialty Medications such as Hepatitis C, HIV, Inflammatory Conditions and Multiple Sclerosis. The Covered Person will pay no more than the Brand Name drug flat Co-payment for Specialty Drugs when active in the program.
