MINUTES 3/3/11**

Concern was voiced over a student who is acting oddly and talking to himself. He is thought to be an automotive student and also has a class with Mr. Johnson. The student is not perceived as dangerous, but odd enough that he is noticed.

Concern was expressed for Caleb Frazier, whose brother was killed due to a drug overdose. This is the second brother he has lost this way. Caleb is Cody Crowell's roommate. Carol heard from Caleb and he said he was doing okay, just trying to keep busy and focused on school. She will follow up some more.

Stacy Bittel requested to let her boyfriend stay over the weekend. The request was granted, then rescinded when Dan found out that he had been in her room overnight during the week. Dan has banned him from the dorms and fined Stacey \$250. He thought she seemed almost relieved. Concern was voiced when Ken Henderson had indicated that the hand injury Stacy claimed to have gotten as an athletic trainer did not fit the accident she described. Kathy Brock concurs with this assessment. There is concern that Stacy is in a domestic violence situation and does not know how to get away. Carol will make up some packets of information about domestic violence/dating violence and give them to Ken and Kathy to share with Stacy.

Rod Killian has dropped two of his four classes. Rita noted that he plans to drop Voc Rehab because he says they are not helping him, and that he cannot handle a full load of classes, which is what they expect.

A male friend of Sarah Schmidt's reported to security that she had been talking about killing herself. Carol attempted to visit her, but could not find her at home. Dan said that she reported to him and to security that she had just had a bad day and was mouthing off. He said that she is basically a level-headed young lady and that he didn't have particular concern.

Tara Barry is not attending class at all. Carol attempted to go see her, but she was not at home. Dan said she hadn't been around the dorms for a couple of days. He was concerned because she had expressed an interest in Aaron Shipley, a former student with a criminal history. Carol will continue to try to see Tara.
