Create a Reservation

In order to determine if you use a Cost Center or a Work Breakdown Structure (WBS) element, view your unit in **ZACCTASSIGNA_RPT**.

When creating a reservation you will be required to select the movement type associated with the structure that finance set up for your unit in GCSS-Army.

- A Cost Center is used to identify the organizational element that executes budget expenses, but is primarily used to track the final costs of materials/work as they are consumed
- WBS element is generally associated with a customer-specific reimbursable or direct charge, or when the WBS element is mission specific.

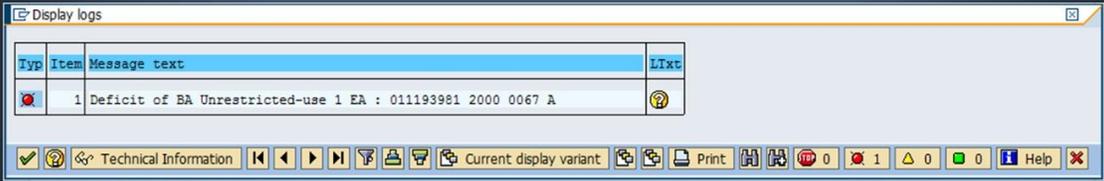

4.3 Deficit of BA Unrestricted

Deficit of BA Unrestricted

- The common error you will see is "Deficit of BA Unrestricted-use 1 EA : 000000000 Material number 200 001Y A".
- This means you have not conducted the Post goods receipt in **VL06i** Inbound Delivery Monitor. You must always conduct the PGR in GCSS-Army in transaction **VL06i** to issue the material.

4.4 Receive Materials

Receive Materials in GCSS-Army

PGR

Conduct a post goods receipt in GCSS-Army in **VL06i**.

What happens?

Your provisional SLoc is increased. If you do not execute the PGR no material will be available to issue to the reservation.

Managing

You must constantly view and manage your material situation in transaction **/ISDFPS/DISP_MAT_SIT**. A **MAT_SIT** with hundreds of expendable lines may point to a supply room that doesn't fully understand the process.

In normal operations Unit Supply Managers will receipt material from the SSA. Receiving material also includes manual increases in **"MIGO"**. In this scenario you will receipt without a reference document.



4.5 Receive Materials (continued)

As a Unit Supply Manager you will use **VL06i** and **MIGO** to receive expendable materials in GCSS-Army:

VL06i

- Check for material availability at the SSA
- Goods receipt an item picked up at the SSA
- Delete an inbound delivery

Use **MIGO** to perform a manual increase to the provisional SLoc (as needed)

ZCANCEL

Unit Supply Managers should execute **ZCANCEL** as part of the pre-deployment and re-deployment preparation or normal document maintenance.

In GCSS-Army, when you cancel the material request line on a reservation or work order, it does not automatically cancel all subsequent documents. If a PR or PO is created, you have to cancel those documents as well.

This could become tedious if you have multiple documents created. The **ZCANCEL** Transaction Code allows Unit Supply Managers to cancel purchasing documents, PR/PO in mass.

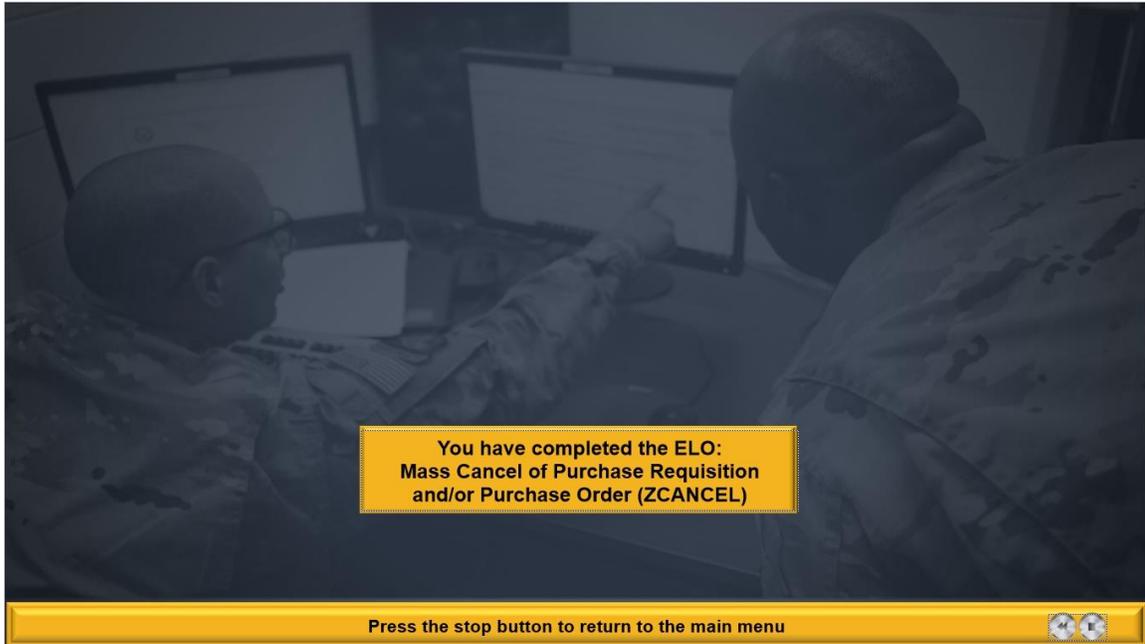

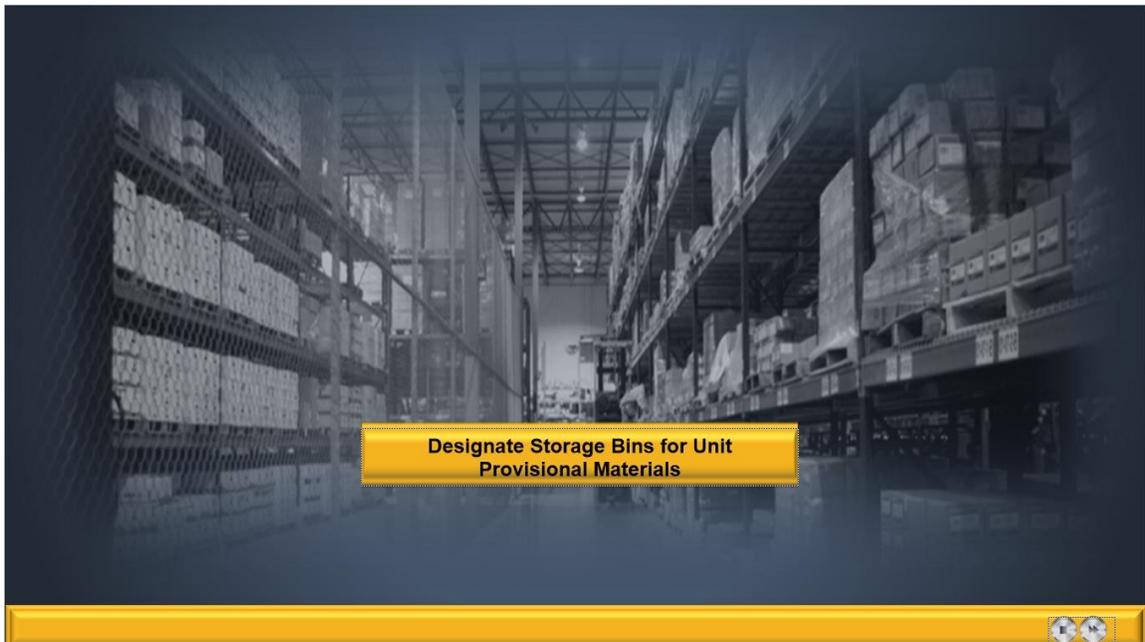

7.7 Integrated Scenario

Integrated Scenario

The Army's Sustainment Readiness Model (SRM) requires units to maintain a constant rate of readiness to ensure their organizations are ready to support combatant commands at a moment's notice. This is a transition from the Army Force Generation Model that outlined a period of reset and retrain for units coming back from recent deployments. In contrast, the Army Sustainment Readiness Model requires units to be ready 100 percent of the time. In this Integrated Scenario, Unit Supply Managers will execute supply readiness operations to ensure they are able to support unit commanders in their mission to deploy at a moment's notice. This requires supply personnel to maintain all supplies, and manage every aspect of property accountability.

Manage Loads: In GCSS-Army loads are managed using manual reservations. Creating a standing supply reservation allows unit supply personnel to reduce the number of material request. Creating a manual reservation for each request could reach in the hundreds and even thousands. Under the SRM, units must be ready at all times. Leaving multiple request open could increase the Unit Supply Manager's workload once they receive orders to temporarily relocate in support of an operation.

Doctrine states that loads should be up to a 15 day stockage for Class II, III, IV and VIII. Based on the Manage Reservation lesson, you will clean up your reservations and create standing supply room reservations for each hand receipt, one for the supply room, and for your loads. Ensure the loads are managed by the doctrinal requirement. Ensure you conduct your actions in order as listed in the Manage Reservations lesson. Remember the effects of improper goods receipt issues and what happens when you receipt material in your inbound delivery monitor.

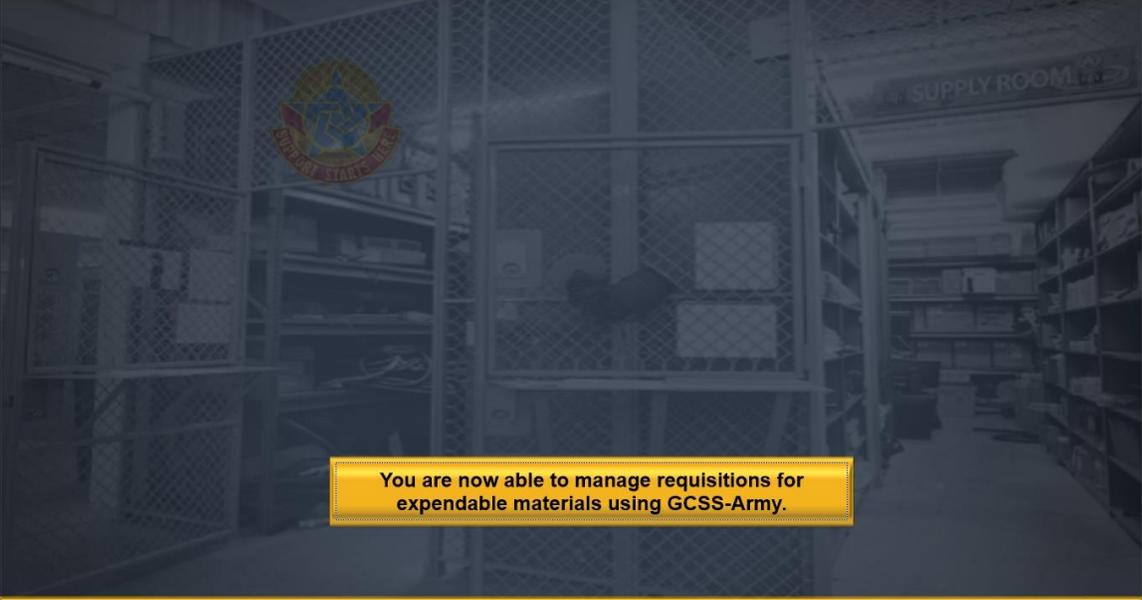
