Safety / Risk Management

General classroom, weapon and electrical equipment safety procedures will be followed. Before starting an inspection and/or performing any maintenance procedures, be sure to clear the weapon. During the clearing procedure always keep the weapon pointed in a safe direction. A potential safety hazard exists if the weapon is assembled or disassembled incorrectly. Students will ensure that safety glasses are worn at all times during the assembly and disassembly of the weapon.

Environmental

NOTE: Instructor should conduct a risk assessment to include environmental considerations IAW the current environmental considerations publication, and ensure students are briefed on hazards and control measures.
NOTE: It is the responsibility of all Soldiers, DA Civilians, and Contractors to protect the environment from damage.
NOTE: Have dirty rags turned in to be cleaned on a weekly basis.
