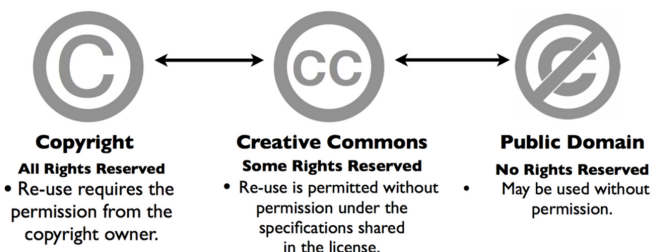
Open Educational Resources (OER) are teaching, learning, and research resources that reside in the creative commons and/or public domain or have been released under an intellectual property license that permits their use and repurposing by others. OER may include full courses, course materials, modules, textbooks, streaming videos, tests...used to support access to knowledge.

Barton Certification Notations

- **No-Cost** - No out-of-pocket expense required of the student for curriculum support materials.
- **Low-Cost** - Up to \$50 curriculum support materials cost for out-of-pocket expenses. (Based on student survey-Spring 2018)
- **Open Textbook** - Course uses an open textbook, but course materials are above the Low-Cost threshold.

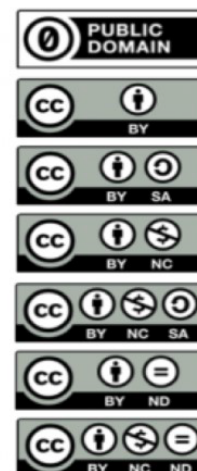
