The Kansas Corequisite Symposium is an interactive, one-day conference for faculty, support staff, and administration to strengthen corequisite English and math instruction and support in Kansas. Through guided conversations and selected presentations, the symposium will provide opportunities to share implementation strategies, successes and challenges and identify best practices.

Topics of Focus

Presentation proposals on practice, curriculum, methodology, or support measures that have been effective in the corequisite model are requested. Topics may include, but are not limited to:

- Online Corequisite Course Development
- Math or English curriculum support
- Advising, placement practices, and enrollment support
- Orientation, Coaching, & Student Support
- Supplemental Resources & Online Support

Who Should Present

Faculty, support staff, and administrators who have lessons learned in the corequisite model, including recipients of the Kansas Sunflower Scholarship Fellowship.

Selection Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated by a review committee on the following criteria:

1. Practical Applications Attendees will walk away with skills, resources, or practices that can be immediately applied to their instruction or support model.
2. Evidence-Based Methods Presentation provides reference to evidenced-based methodologies or frameworks applied to corequisite instruction, implementation, or support.
3. Needs of Symposium Participants Presentation addresses content requests shared by symposium registrants.
