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PERFORMANCE ENSEMBLES

Band meets Thursday evening in the spring semester and Orchestra meets during the regular afternoon spring semester schedule. Hilltop Singers MUSI 1014: Enrollment is by audition only. Auditions are held in the spring for the following year. Members of Hilltop Singers are selected for the fall and spring semesters and also required to enroll in Concert Choir. Each Hilltop Singer receives a Performance Award. The ensemble includes one drummer, bass player and guitarist. Due to the rehearsal/practice time conflicts, it is not possible for most athletes to participate in Hilltop Singers.
