Executive Summary Medical Assistant Program Alignment

The Medical Assistant Program Alignment was originally approved by the Kansas Board of Regents (KBOR) during its meeting on April 20, 2011. KBOR staff reviewed this alignment in January, 2013 and determined that changes needed to be made to ensure adequate exit points for students.

The Revised Medical Assistant Alignment allows for three different end points as listed below:

- 1. Certificate B Maximum 44 Credit Hours
 - Credentials available
 - o RMA
 - CCMA (must be an accredited institution with CAAHEP)
- 2. Certificate C Maximum 54 Credit hours
 - Credential available
 - o CMA Credential (must be an accredited institution with CAAHEP)
- 3. An AAS degree with a maximum of 65 credits for state funding
 - RMA or CCMA or CMA Credential (CCMA and CMA credentials require institution to be accredited with CAAHEP)
 - The AAS degree requires 15 credit hours of General Education (Minimum)

Common Courses within Program - 7 Credits

No change from original 2011 Alignment

- The following courses are required for the state's program alignment. The outcomes and competencies are not subject to change.
 - Medical Administrative Aspects 4 credits
 - o Emergency Preparedness 1 credit
 - Medical Professional Issues 2 credits

Required Support Courses –(up to) 8 credits

No change from original 2011 Alignment

- The following courses are required for the state's program alignment. The outcomes and competencies are not subject to change.
 - Medical Terminology 3 credits
 - o Anatomy and Physiology (or) Human Body in Health and Disease (up to) 5 credits
 - Institutions may utilize existing like courses which adhere to the agreed upon course lengths and competences

- A Certificate B comprised of 44 credit hours
 - Students will be eligible to complete the RMA Credential

- Elimination of the Certificate C offering
 - Accreditation is required for students to complete both the CPC & the CPCcredentials
