Employee 1 Questions/Comments:

Question concerning the following paragraph:

• Internship, practicum, field experience and on-the-job training clinical courses must meet the for a minimum required by the respective professional accrediting or regulatory agency of 45 hours (60 minute hour) per credit hour.

Does this mean that an internship that does not have an accrediting or regulatory agency overseeing will default to the time-based standard for credit hours? If this is the case, would that be the standard for a laboratory course?

Case in point: NATG 1165 Natural Gas Tech Internship does not have professional accrediting or regulatory agency. This is a 1-4 credit hour internship, credits awarded based on clock time "on-the-job" at the rate of 45 clock hours per credit.
