Barton Community College The College is a comprehensive institution community college. It will that offers educational programs for career preparation, academic transfer to four-year colleges and universities, developmental studies, and a range of extended services to meet the life-long learning needs of its citizens.

Coursework leading to certificate and degree completion is governed by the Learning, Instruction and Curriculum Committee. The committee facilitates a process that ensures consistency of curriculum across the instructional system regardless of venue and modality. The committee safeguards statewide transfer and workforce alignments as well as college to university articulation agreements. In addition, the committee addresses academic integrity, coursework rigor, instructional standards, and assessment of student learning.

It is the policy of the College's instructional programs to strive to adhere to the "Barton-Governance Manual" as established by the Board of Trustees and those of any accreditation-bodies with which it is formally associated.
