We will add language to the Category 2 description stating the requirement to follow all appropriate laws, regulations, and licensing requirements and that the license must be on file with the EDIA with the request form. Here are the responses: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Outside groups must partner with one of the two allowed sponsoring entities at any time while renting space on campus if they would like to serve alcohol. This allows us to maintain security and compliance with all relevant rules, regulations, and laws regarding alcohol service and consumption. Within this policy, alcohol consumption is permitted at other locations across campus; this policy does not apply to Camp Aldrich. • The Cougar Den has alcohol at select games, pending approved requests in accordance with the policy, provided as part of membership of the group.
