

Dietary Manager Online Degree

Looking for an online program in the dietetics field?

Interested in food, nutrition and management? Then you may be interested in the field of dietary management or dietetics.

Barton Community College offers an online 16 credit hour dietary manager certificate. The certificate qualifies students to take the Association of Nutrition and Foodservice Professionals (ANFP) Certification exam. Courses include Sanitation, Management of Food Systems, Nutrition, and Human Resource Management. Students must be endorsed by a healthcare facility and Registered Dietitian.

If you choose to continue your education, Barton also offers a 2 + 2 transfer program with Kansas State University (KSU). This program allows students to complete the first two years of the Bachelor of Science degree in Dietetics at Barton with the final two years completed through KSU. Through this program students earn an Associate in Science with emphasis in predietetics or dietary management from Barton.
