



BUILDING OPERATIONS ENGINEER

KAKE, the ABC affiliate in Wichita, KS, has an opening for a Building Operations Engineer. This position is responsible for maintaining the KAKE facilities, building, and related broadcast video and audio electronic equipment, as well as repairing various computer-based editing and automation systems.

PRIMARY DUTIES:

- Building maintenance and repair, as well as performing maintenance on all internal equipment. This includes troubleshooting and repairing equipment at the component level.
- Responsible for the functionality, safety, and cleanliness of the facility, including upkeep and frequent assessment of HVAC, plumbing, and electrical systems. Key duties include fixing broken fixtures, painting, landscaping, and maintaining detailed maintenance logs.
- Responsible for ensuring upkeep of the various transmitter sites operated by KAKE, including reasonable lawn maintenance and upkeep, to protect valuable equipment from the elements.
- Responsible for maintenance and scheduling repairs of company vehicles.
- Assist in all matters related to the repair of electronic equipment, including ongoing maintenance to maximize functionality and life of the component.
- Assist the Chief Engineer with planning and design of new and replacement broadcast electronic and computer systems.
- Position could require working with high AC, DC, and RF voltages in transmission equipment.
- Must be available for on-call emergencies and available during severe or extreme weather events.

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED:

- Minimum of two-year trade or technical school or Associate's Degree in the specialized study of electronics theory and maintenance of electronics-based systems.
- At least one-year prior experience in broadcast operations (Master Control and VTR) is preferred.
- Experience in maintaining studio broadcast equipment and knowledge of computer and networking systems.
- Experience with non-linear editing, newsroom, and master control automation systems.
- General knowledge of mechanical based equipment, including lawn maintenance equipment.
- Good eyesight and hearing, and ability to lift equipment that may exceed 50 pounds.
- Must have a valid driver's license and a driving record compliant with our Vehicle Safety Policy.
