Responsibilities:

- Must be detail oriented in work habits along with being able to adapt quickly to changing demands and circumstances while maintaining programming on air.
- Must have a good and proficient working knowledge of monitoring video, audio, power and signal levels for transmitters, recorders, servers and receivers.
- Code and direct any newscast, breaking news or news special.
- Must have a good and proficient working knowledge of all aspects of newscast production, including studio camera work and audio
- Consult with and provide input to department related to our on-air look and operation.
- Must be able to interact with other departments in a professional and detailed manner.
- Must be available on-call and for vacation and sick leave fill in.
- Perform other duties as assigned by upper management.
