### Cozy Mysteries

*Mystery fiction that features amateur sleuths, socially intimate settings, and a light-hearted tone.* A sub-genre often featuring a highly educated amateur detective solving a crime within a close-knit, middle-class community (e.g., a small inn or summer house). Cozies may feature suspects that belong to a specific set of people such as bakers, knitters, or gardeners, or they may follow a theme. This sub-genre is closely related to the classic mystery formula, except for the lack of explicit sex, overt violence, or profanity, and the crime is typically a bloodless one. For instance, the actual act of murder is never described in detail, only the discovery of the body. There may be a police presence during the investigation, but they remain more or less accepting of the amateur sleuth. The tone can be serious, but is often lighthearted, playful, or humorous. Agatha Christie's *The Murder at the Vicarage* (1930), Elizabeth Daly's *Unexpected Night* (1940), Mary Rinehart's *The Yellow Room* (1945), and Lillian Jackson Braun's *The Cat Who Could Read Backwards* (1966) are classic examples.

### Common Elements

No graphic descriptions of the crime

No gruesome details of the murder

### Benefits of Reading

Introduces readers to quaint towns, zany characters, and unlikely professions and hobbies

Suggests to readers that ordinary people

can resolve situations and bring order to chaos

Allows readers to follow the investigation and find satisfaction in its resolution
