Patron Conduct

The Barton Library is dedicated to providing a welcoming and safe environment for all patrons. Our goal is to support academic needs and offer a place for relaxation. To ensure a positive experience for everyone, we have established the following guidelines for patron conduct:

Patron Rights and Responsibilities

- All Library users are entitled to enjoy library services, materials, and facilities without unreasonable interference.
- Patrons are expected to respect each other's rights to study and use library resources peacefully.

General Conduct Expectations

- Patrons must engage in appropriate behavior that promotes a safe and quiet atmosphere.
- Conduct that creates disturbances is not allowed.
- Patrons must not engage in illegal activities.
- Personal items should not obstruct pathways, and unattended belongings are not the Library's responsibility.

Prohibited Behaviors

- Actions that disrupt others or violate policies and laws will not be tolerated, including:
 - o Loud noise or disruptive behavior.
 - o Harassment or verbal abuse of staff or patrons.
 - o Theft or vandalism of public and/or private property.
 - o Indecent exposure or sexual conduct.
 - o Bringing animals (except service animals) into the Library.
 - o Using Library facilities for personal grooming or bathing.

Consuming alcohol or illegal substances.

Enforcement and Consequences

- Library staff will address inappropriate behavior based on the College's Student Code of Conduct.
- If a patron behaves disruptively, staff may request that they leave. If needed, Campus Safety will be contacted.
- Serious or repeated violations may result in suspension of library privileges.

Appeal Process:

 Patrons may appeal Library decisions or actions by speaking with the director, or by sending an email or letter.
