With safety at the forefront of our mind, Campus Safety would like to encourage you to download the Barton Guardian, a free mobile app that turns your smartphone into a personal safety device.

By downloading the app on your mobile phone, you can invite friends and family to join your network as your "Guardians." You can then request one or more of your Guardians to virtually walk with you on or off campus. It's like having an emergency blue light system and a trusted friend with you at all times.

The app also has a safety feature that directly connects you to Campus Safety (or 911 on/off-campus) in an emergency situation, as well as the ability to submit an anonymous tip to Campus Safety should you see something suspicious.
