
Hello Barton!

Don't use overdrive or cruise control on icy roads.

WHAT TO DO IF..

MY REAR TIRES SKID

Take your foot off of the accelerator.

Steer in the direction you want the front wheels to go. If your rear tires are skidding to the left, steer left to regain control.

If you have standard brakes, pump them gently.

If you have anti-lock brakes, apply steady pressure.

Don't worry if you feel your anti-lock brakes pulse-this is normal.



MY FRONT TIRES SKID



Take your foot off the gas and shift to neutral.

Don't try to steer immediately.

As the wheels skid and the vehicle slows, steer in the direction you want to go.

At this point, you can put the vehicle back into "drive" and gently accelerate.

If you have anti-lock brakes, apply steady pressure.

Don't worry if you feel your anti-lock brakes pulse-this is normal.
