Club & Organization Funding

The Club and Organization Funding is a incentive to become involved with Student Government Association (SGA) and give community and/or campus service back in return. The following will give a description on how that can be accomplished.

First, if your Club/Organization is made up of students that receive scholarships, or performance awards to participate you will not be eligible.

Clubs/Organizations have the opportunity to apply for as much as \$500 at the beginning of the fall semester. **Before a club/organization can apply for this money, a current constitution and club roster needs to be on file.**

The application needs to state how the money will be used and how it will benefit their organization. *The written application needs to be submitted to the SGA by September 18, 2018.* The SGA will review the applications twice at two different scheduled meetings. The first reading is for any questions that might arise from the application. Then second reading is to have answers to those questions and vote on the amount that will be given. The questions that might arise are addressed through the sponsor by email or phone.

In return, the Club/Organization receiving this money will have two members (an active member and an alternate) to be a part of Clubs & Organizations Meetings. The active member will need to attend meetings, help their club get involved in student activities. If the active member is not able to meet his/her obligation then the alternate will need to step forward.

*This applies only to the club/organization at Barton County campus. For student organizations at locations other than the Barton County campus, club members should be prepared to provide student input/assistance with activities or events at their respective campuses when the occasional need arises.

*Only 1 meeting absences per semester will be excused in the academic year only applies to the Barton County Campus clubs.

Each club/organization will require each member 5 hrs of campus service or community service during the academic year. A written or verbal report would need to be presented to the SGA in the spring semester describing the service project(s). If a club fails to meet the obligations, it could possibly affect funding for the next year.
