This messaging system allows subscribers to receive alerts concerning campus emergencies and closings (weather) through email and/or text messaging. Additional notifications can include changes in the normal routine in housing (repair or maintenance work, reminder of cafeteria closing or changes in meal times and etc.) and a notice on the day of a student activity (that's keeping it "smooth").

- **Register:** means to create an account. [Click on the register button](#) on the upper right hand side of the web page. Complete the information, use an email address that can be read from your phone (suggested - not necessary) and the student's mobile number. **The email address and password will be used to sign into the messaging & alert system. Save this info with your other passwords so when you leave Barton you can deactivate your account-you're in control.*
- **A message will be sent to your email account.** Use that information to sign into the messaging system for the first time. You are almost done.
- **Now join (3) groups:** Barton County Campus, BCC Housing - (if it applies) & BCC Student Activity. At the top locate and click on "Find Groups". Then click on the group name and click join. Once you have join the groups they should show up under the "Group" tab. If you register and don't join any groups, no messages will go to the register email address or the register cell phone.
