

# COUGAR MESSAGING

**Go to:** [www.getrave.com/login/bcc](http://www.getrave.com/login/bcc)

This messaging system allows subscribers to receive text and email alerts concerning campus emergencies and closings. Additional notifications can include housing updates such as repair or maintenance work, reminder of cafeteria closings, changes in meal times, activities, etc.

- **Click on the “Register” button** on the upper right hand side of the web page. Complete the information. *\*The email address and password will be used to sign into the messaging & alert system. Save this info with your other passwords so when you leave Barton you can deactivate your account.*
- **A message will be sent to your email account.** Use that information to sign into the messaging system for the first time. You are almost done.
- **Now join (3) groups:** “Barton County Campus”, “BCC Student Activity”, and “BCC Housing” (if you will be living on campus). At the top locate and click on “Find Groups”. Then click on the group name and click join. Once you have joined the groups they should show up under the “Group” tab.  
If you register and don’t join any groups, no messages will be sent.

Housing students are required to register for Cougar Messaging. At Housing Check-In, there will be a station to sign up. If you go to the station and are already on our list as being registered, you will be able to pass through that station and on to the next.
